What is Tree Climbing?

Get to grips with nature on this fun recreational climbing activity. You will learn about the rope systems used for scaling trees whilst prusiking your way up through the canopy. During the session you may also get a chance to try slacklining and some bushcraft activities.


What is Orienteering?

Sport Ident (Digital orienteering) is an engaging way to find controls using a map. Gone are the days of using pin stamps. You can take part for fun or competitively and don't need any previous experience. Courses will be set up throughout the Lodge Grounds.

Where is the venue?

This activity will be based at the Lodge Grounds in North Berwick.
